Grant Guidelines and Application

The purpose of this grant is to help nontraditional, 25 years of age or older at the time of enrollment, who are current Illinois State University students, to fund incidental one-time unmet expenses. Please read these guidelines carefully. Incomplete applications will be returned to the applicant.

Each candidate for a Dr. Dorothy E. Lee Grant should meet the following qualifications:

- A. Full or part time nontraditional undergraduate students, 25 years of age or older, who are enrolled in a degree program, or have been admitted as an adult learner with the intention to enroll in a degree program, at Illinois State University.
- B. Submission of a grant request, which identifies the need for money for incidental one-time expenses. Priority is given to emergency expenses. The grant has funded childcare expenses, books and academic supplies, transportation, computer repair, tutoring, and the like. Grants do not cover groceries, non-emergency utility bills, rent (except in cases of eviction), mortgage payments, or debt. **Documentation of expenses (with receipts)**MUST be submitted with the grant application! Each grant is considered on its own merit and on available funds at the time of application. Applications are accepted all year and will be awarded until the grant amount has expired.
